Student Assistance Program

The purpose of the Texas Allied Poultry Association (TAPA) Student Assistance Program is to provide financial help to undergraduate college students pursuing undergraduate degrees in poultry science and related fields.

This assistance may be in the form of financial aid for tuition, lab fees, books, or other needs as determined by the TAPA Student Assistance Program Committee. Assistance will be determined annually based on fundraising levels.

Scholarships will be awarded based on need demonstrated by an application and 400 word essay submitted to the TAPA Student Assistance Program Committee. Input from the students' advisors and Department Head will be utilized in a final determination.

The following criteria must be met for consideration:

- 1) Student must have completed 60 hours:
- 2) Student must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 with a minimum GPA of 2.75 within their major discipline.

In addition to the above criteria, other determining factors will include extracurricular activities, leadership ability, and work ethic.

The TAPA awards three different types of scholarships. All scholarship applicants must meet the above criteria for consideration. Some scholarships have additional requirements and students must specify the scholarship for which they are applying. The individual types are as follows:

- 1) General TAPA Scholarship
- 2) Jimmy Singleton or K.E. Jacob Memorial
- 3) TAPA/TPF Children's Scholarship
- 4) Dick Creger Memorial
- 5) James and Walline Grimm

Jimmy Singleton and K.E. "Jake" Jacob Memorial Scholarships

- 1) Students must meet the basic requirement of the TAPA Student Assistance Program. These requirements include a completed application and a four hundred word essay that should give a description of the student and outline why the student deserves consideration for the TAPA scholarship.
- 2) The candidate's family should include an active member of the Texas Poultry Federation or one of its affiliates.
- 3) The candidate's family is a commercial grower for the poultry industry.

- 4) If either number 2 or 3 cannot be met, the scholarship will be awarded based on the criteria for the General TAPA Scholarship.
- 5) TAPA will award a scholarship in each name at both Texas A&M and Stephen F. Austin State University.

#### General TAPA Scholarship

- 1) Students must meet the basic requirements for TAPA Student Assistance Program. These requirements include a complete application and a 400 word essay that should give a description of the student and outline why the student deserves consideration for the TAPA scholarship.
- 2) TAPA will award scholarships to students at Texas A&M and Stephen F. Austin State University.

#### TAPA/TPF Children's Scholarship

- 1) Students must meet the basic requirements of the TAPA Student Assistance Program. These requirements include a complete application and a 400 word essay that should give a description of the student and outline why the student deserves consideration for the TAPA scholarship.
- 2) Applicants are not limited to agricultural disciplines.
- 3) Applicants' parent must be an active member of TAPA/TPF.
- 4) Applicants are not limited to Texas A&M and Stephen F. Austin Universities.
- 5) Successful applicants will be determined based on their academic performance.
- 6) Additional scholarships can be added depending upon student response.
- 7) Final selections will be made by an outside committee.

Winner determination will be made during the month of November. Scholarships will be awarded directly to the University Scholarship Accounts and will be credited toward your tuition for the spring semester. Dispensation in a manner other than the above method can be arranged for special circumstances on a case by case basis as approved by the TAPA Scholarship Committee. Successful candidates cannot be awarded this scholarship more than twice for a total of \$3,000.00.
